Kevin Cronin, OFM was scheduled to travel to Cincinnati for our Community Retreat in October, but because of the COVID-19 Delta variant, we decided to have a quiet retreat that included a few DVD presentations by Fr. Kevin. We thank Fr. Kevin for sharing his recorded presentations with us! We hope to have Fr. Kevin guide our Community Retreat in 2023. Sr. Vickie, however, was not able to participate in our Community Retreat this year because she was one of the Poor Clare “winners” of a two-week pilgrimage to Rome, Assisi and Padua. Sr. Vickie was able to share moments from the pilgrimage through her Facebook page, so many of you were able to join her on pilgrimage.

The seasons continue to change, even with the pandemic still among us. Luckily, most of the leaves were off the trees in time for our Annual Leaf Raking Day.
