During this pandemic, we have experienced loneliness and sadness. Many of us cannot meet face-to-face, and we are grateful for the technology that allows us to connect with each other in other innovative ways. We pray that St. Clare will intercede for us, providing us with comfort during this difficult time, and bring healing to our world. We pray that this letter finds you and all your loved ones well. We continue to pray that a vaccine is ready soon and that distribution of the vaccine goes swiftly. The year 2020 is one we are not likely to forget. May the year 2021 be a year of good health and the end of the pandemic.
