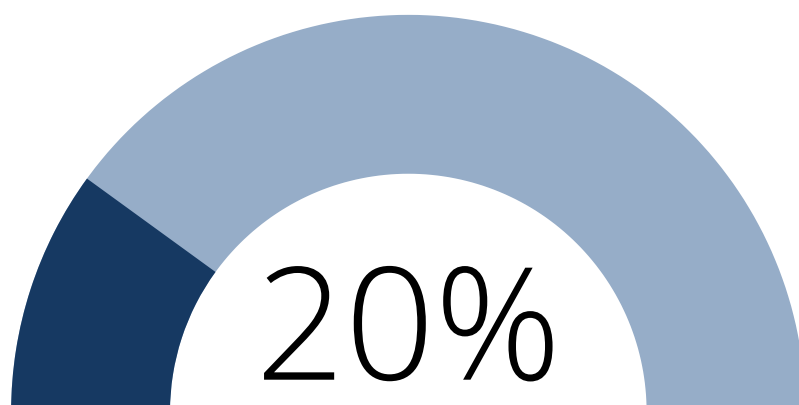

St. Paul's Lutheran School joyfully announces a matching grant opportunity with the Patterson Family Foundation out of Kansas City. Mr. Poppe applied for and received notice of approval for up to \$10,000 from the Patterson Family Foundation with \$10,000 being raised by St. Paul's Lutheran School. The money raised will be utilized to grow and provide sustainability to the counseling programming provided at St. Paul's Lutheran School.
