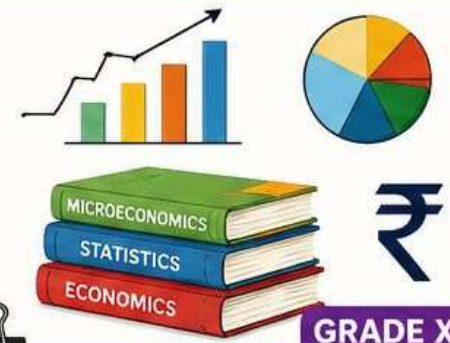

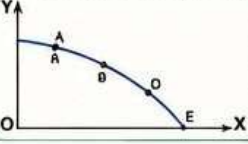

Conceptual Explanations

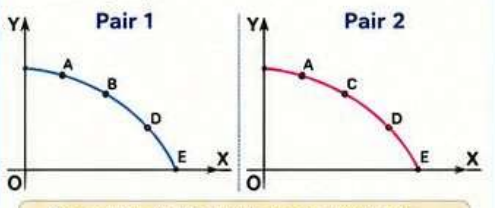
- What is Scarcity? (with real-life examples)

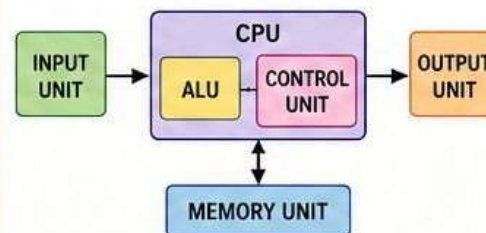
