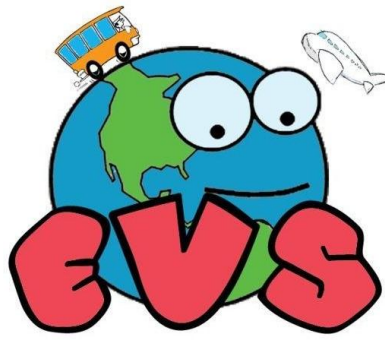

Mathematics or 'Math' is an ancient subject that has fascinated mankind, and can be found useful while doing almost anything. As an example let us take 'FOOD'. Mathematics is related to food in many ways. The connection of food and Mathematics starts early in life. So, let's create a Mathematics Food game and have some fun.

Materials Required

- 1) An old Cardboard or Plastic Box.(to be decorated with food pictures)
- 2) Make Picture cut-outs of some Food item, of India example: Ladoo, Idli, Vada, Dhokla, Momos, etc (Select only one Food item)
- 3) Make at least 20 cut-outs of any one food item. Paste it on a thick sheet. (Mark 8 out of these 20 Cut-Outs with a big red star mark on top of the food picture).
- 4) A4 size sheet to play the game/activity.
- 5) On 12 cut-outs, write random 5 or 6 digit numbers behind them.
- 6) On the remaining 8 cut-outs (marked with red star) write the following at the back:
 - Place Value (Indian system)
 - Face Value (Indian system)
 - Predecessor
 - Successor
 - Expanded Form
 - Compare

- Add or (+)
- Place Value (International system)

INSTRUCTIONS to Play

Example:

- 1) From your Food-box pick up the Picture of 1 Ladoo. Then pick up another Ladoo with the red star marked randomly.
- 2) Now turn-over both the Ladoos and see what is written behind it.
Example:- Ladoo picture says - 42352

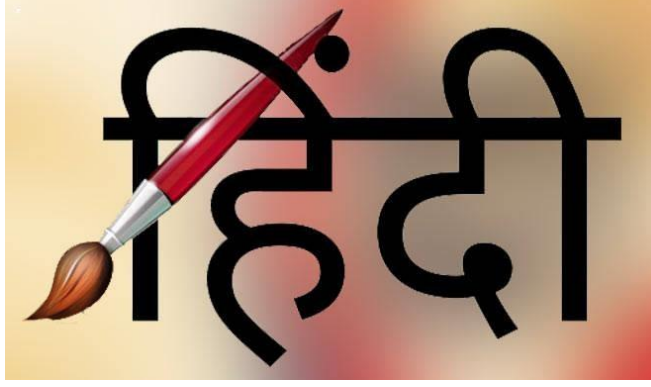
Red Star Ladoo says : Place Value (Indian)

- 3) Then on your A4 size sheet write the number and it's Place Value, according to the Indian Place Value system.
- 4) If you see 'Addition' or 'Compare' then pick up another Ladoo picture, and write your answer in the A4 sheet.
