'If you cannot do great things, do small things in a great way' This year's summer assignment for English is based on the book 'Adventure in Kaziranga''(Available online) four environment novellas by Arup Kumar Dutta. These stories are set in the beautiful state of Assam, which is home to the world – famous Kaziranga National park. It is a wild life sanctuary where the guards protect the animals of Kaziranga from their main enemy – man. We want our students to raise their level of awareness regarding conservation of Nature and wild life animals. All sixth graders are going to be a part of a huge anti – poaching forum and everyone will showcase their love for animals!

With reference to 'Adventures in Kaziranga', do the following Activities:

- 1. Look at the picture on page 89. Write a short paragraph in your grammar notebook, using your imagination and your knowledge about elephants. Describe the relationship between a baby elephant and its father or mother. Do these gentle giants show protective feelings like humans? Provide your answer in your paragraph. Attach a photocopy of this picture to your notebook, next to the paragraph. If anyone is good in drawing try to draw the picture in the note book.
- Kaziranga National Park in Assam is home to the endangered Great Indian Rhinoceros. Make a colourful collage on a standard A3 sheet using pictures, slogans, information about any <u>one</u> wildlife sanctuary in India. You can chose from:
- (i) Kaziranga Wildlife Sanctuary, Assam
- (ii) Bandhavgarh National Park, Madhya Pradesh
- (iii) Corbett National Park, Uttarakhand.
- (iv) Ranthambore National Park, Rajasthan.

- 3. 'Save the Pool' page 5 45, tell us about the brave efforts of some young boys to fight the poachers and their evil, greedy ways. Learning about saving animals, as you read this story, there is another interesting aspect: the use of the mother tongue by the author! Make a list of at least 7 Hindi words that have been used in this section. Create a neat table along with their usage in a new sentence of yours in the Grammar notebook.
- 4. Read the story, 'Lonely Deer' from page 155 166. The boys help save the deer that has wandered from the sanctuary into the village. Using this same theme and plot. Rewrite the story in short, in about a page or two in your grammar notebook. Include your friends and yourself and give a new name to the village, substitute the deer with a baby tiger or a baby rhino. Give your story a new title.

SORTING MATERIALS INTO GROUPS

We see a phenomenal amount of things around us – air, water, plants, stones, hard things, soft things.....and the list goes on..... Everything has its own characteristics and properties. Things can be classified into groups. so Let's get started.

If you wish to - take a picture of yourself, in school uniform, doing the

- > Soft Materials: Materials that can be compressed easily. Example- cotton, foam.
- > <u>Hard Materials</u> : Materials which are difficult to compress. Example- stone, brick.

> Lustrous Materials : Materials which shine or have lustre and are generally metals. Example - copper, brass.

> Non lustrous Materials :Materials that do not have lustre. Example- wood,cloth.

> Soluble Materials: Materials that dissolve in a liquid. Example- salt, sugar dissolve in water.

> Insoluble Materials: Materials that do not dissolve in a liquid. Example- sand, stones in water.
> Miscible Liquids : Liquids that dissolve in another

liquid. Example- vinegar or glycerine in water.

> Immiscible or non-miscible Materials: Liquids which do not mix and form a separate layer. examplekerosene, coconut oil in water.

> Floating Materials: Materials which are lighter than water AND float on its surface. Example- wood, plastic.

> Sinking Materials: Substances which are denser or heavier than water. Example- stone, metal.

> <u>Having Odour</u> :Materials which have a distinctive smell. Example- mosquito repellents, flowers.

> <u>Odourless Materials</u>: Materials which do not have a smell. Example- water, oxygen

> <u>Transparent Materials</u>: Materials through which objects on their other side can be seen.example- glass, cellophane.

> Translucent Materials: Materials that allow light to pass through them partially.example-frosted glass,butter paper

> Opaque Materials: Materials through which you cannot see. Example- cardboard,wood
