

This year's summer assignment for English is based on the book 'The Stranger and other curious stories' (Available online). The fourteen stories in this collection have been contributed by the members of the Association of Writers and Illustrators for children, India. All the stories are about curious happenings.

The word curious means odd, peculiar, queer or strange. These stories should be read for pure enjoyment and the surprise element that they have. Do you like to watch a movie that has a predictable plot and ending? Our guess is No. That's why we want you to appreciate the unpredictable twists and turns in these stories.

With reference to the curious stories that you read, do the following activities:

- 1. Refer to the story 'Another Time' on page 25. Try to rewrite this story in brief using the Taj Mahal or the Qutub Minar as a setting. Imagine suddenly meeting the historical character related to the place and create a similar short story. Do this task using about 2 pages of your Grammar notebook. You may also stick a colourful picture of the monument.
- 2. Make a colourful collage on a standard A3 sheet using photographs and information about your grandmother or grandfather. Give a catchy heading about her or him being your favourite person. Write a few lines about the interests and activities that you share. Make sure you read the beautiful and emotional story 'Always with you' on page 35. It will be a reminder that we should cherish and value the relationship that we share with our grandparents.
- 3. Page 45, 'The House at the Back', page 75, 'A Secret Friend' and page 85, 'One Strange Morning'. All 3 stories have a common theme. Try to read at least 2 of the stories. Collect information and find out about some famous stories and legends with a supernatural element. Make a small project of 2 pages in your Grammar notebook using pictures, clippings and some written information. Give it a catchy title like: 'Can this be true?' or 'A world of unexplained happenings.'

4. Here's your chance to do some research and make an interesting list.
