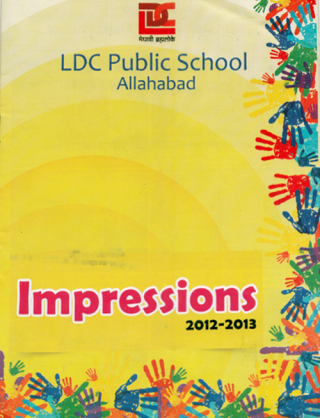

## War on Plastic

### Why not follow Delhi dairy's example and supply of milk by cans?

These days the use of polythene bags has made things very easy for traders who have been using them for packing their goods on a large scale. Till recently only dry stuff was packed. But now liquid too is being stuffed in these polythene bags. Even if a ban were to be imposed on the use of polythene in mela area there will be the administration stop polythene packed milk pouches from entering Maha Kumbh. But the Mother Dairy in Delhi has shown the way. It is again experimenting with the resumption of milk supply through cans. I may add that in Allahabad the Parag Dairy has been doing this all time along with pouched supply. Every morning one can see Parag Vans carrying tankers loaded with milk. But they don't go from house to house to supply milk to domestic customers. They distribute milk in bulk supply to tea stalls and road side eating houses. In selected colonies, some of the Parag tankers are doing that then I am not aware of it.

All that Parag would have to do is to popularize the alternative system of can supply among the people. I may mention that in the past, when the pouch system had not to moms in a vogue, these dairies used to supply sealed bottled milk. The dairy people would ring the bell place two bottles (or as money required) and take back the two empty ones delivered with milk a day earlier. In case people were awake, they would just transfer the milk from the bottles instantly and return the empty container to them. But sometime the bottles would fall and break. Demurrage charges had to be paid but that was once in a blue moon. So far as pollution is concerned, the bottle supply ensured that there was none. But supply through pouches adds to the pollution because people just don't care at all about how they are discarding them. Doubts may arise about the integrity of the milkman coming with the can supply. This was ensured in the past by locking the cans so that milk could only be withdrawn from it and not transferred that may sound laughable today because these days, when cooking gas can be transferred, why not milk? But there is no guarantee that what you getting in pouches is also original and pure. This is because a TV news channel recently flashed how synthetic milk was being poured into pouches having the print line of popular dairies. They were seen sealing the fake bags by joining the edges through the heat from a candle flame.
