The copy of the pledge is enclosed herewith.

Further, ECI song 'Main Bharat Hoon' will be launched on the day of NVD, the link of which will be made available on ECI website (www.eci.gov.in & www.ecisveep.eci.in) from 1:00 PM on 25th January 2023. The officers in the State Govt. Departments and PSUs as well as the educational institutions may be asked to play the song and upload the photographs on their social media handles using hashtag #MainBharatHoon, #VoteDemocracy.

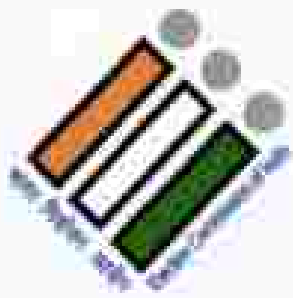
