Minutes of the meeting held on 12.01.2023 at Harjota Bhawan, New Delhi under the Chairmanship of Hon'ble Chief Minister, Haryana regarding hosting of the 1st Anti-Corruption Working Group Meeting planned at Gurgaon on March 1-3, 2023 within the State's G-30 Presidency Year, 2023.

The meeting deliberated various matters relating to the G-30 presidency year of India/Haryana campaign and the State Government's resolve towards making the same successful in Haryana & across the State. Sh. Harpal Singh, IAS, Addl. Secretary, DoPT, report of India giving a final presentation on 'Excellence from Haryana State' followed by another presentation by the Deputy Commissioner, Gurgaon on the action taken so far by the district administration and State Government for preparations for the upcoming the 1st Anti-Corruption Working Group Meeting at Gurgaon on March 1-3, 2023.

With various deliberations, the following action points emerged from the meeting:

1. The 1st Anti-Corruption Working Group Meeting will see participation from 20 member countries (10 IAS, 11 invited countries) and 5 multilateral organizations of the United World. Gurgaon District between 100-150 delegates will also part in the meeting. The Ministry of External Affairs will provide facilitation and other support of travel, lodging of hotel for the actual meet and booking of rooms at the hotel. Arrangements for the 'Gate Drive' (March 1, 2023 evening) around 100 March 1, 2023) and other decorations and cultural events are to be taken by Government of Haryana.

3. The Department of Information, Public Relations, Culture and Language, Government of Haryana (DIPROCL) will provide complete branding for the event (in all aspects like visual) on the theme of one of IT as sub-competition measure in August, 2023 Haryana's culture. There will also be threat-based branding from about 10th June.

[Action by: Department of Information, Public Relations, Culture and Language]

4. There will be four stalls at the venue 3 stalls will be provided by Government of India (one for PMO, IIT, GAIL and UPI) and others, whereas a 4th stall will be setup by Haryana Government. It was decided that the DIPROCL will erect the 4th stall which will use above theme, any content and an event on Haryana's accomplished athletes using former Haryana Police and other resources.

5. The Protocol Committee notified by the Government of Haryana vide no. SPO 892/2022 dated 21.01.2022 and the District Administration, Gurgaon were directed to meet the key personnel on special arrangements with the venue authorities for a Gala Dinner at approximately 200 delegates plus senior representatives of the Government of Haryana on evening of March 4, 2023 at A-Cat, near Laxmi Nagar, Gurgaon.

6. The Tourism Department was directed to provide adequate Golf Caddies for the participation of the delegates from the hosting venue to A-Cat (Gurgaon) venue. The Logistics and Transportation Committee notified by the Government of Haryana vide no. SPO 211/22 Pn dated 27/12/2022 will make arrangements to provide the Golf Caddies to be used for the event at A-Cat during the Gala Dinner.

7. The Cultural Committee notified by the Government of Haryana vide no. SPO 211/22 Pn dated 27/12/2022 and the Director, Art and Culture, Govt. of Haryana was directed to provide a Cultural Event in consultation with MCA's (SAC, IITG) and their representatives at A-Cat for the Gala Dinner to be held on 04.03.2023. The event will include pre-dinner preparations for stage acts, moderator, singer, musicians at the Gala Dinner showcasing final traditions of Haryana. It was also decided that the cultural event should be approx. 30 minutes long and shall not exceed 45 minutes.

8. The Information, Public Relations, Culture & Language Department was directed to design and develop a Haryana-themed menu for the Gala Dinner highlighting the cultural diversity for all delegates. It was also decided to setup a State Government's website in Hindi around the venue of Gala Dinner.

9. Public order arrangements, Gurgaon has directed to invite senior representatives of Government of Haryana and Haryana Officers, Chief Minister, Speaker and Members in the Gala Dinner and request Liaison Officers will accompany for the Gala Dinner.

- 10. To provide an illustration of the importance of G-20 meetings, it was decided that a National Action Plan (NAP) G-20 Presidency and 1st Anti-Corruption Working Group Meeting will be held in Gurgaon by the Foreign Cooperation Department along with the rollout of a new room in consultation with District Administration Gurgaon.

- 11. The Department of Higher Education was directed to hold seminars, essay writing competitions, and events at the level of Faculty or College & Universities and other Govt. Institutions and the Anti-Corruption Working Group Meeting. The details of these events are attached and referred to Foreign Department for consideration before during the discussion planned on March 4, 2023.

- 12. The District Council, Gurgaon, Public Relations and Language was directed to arrange publicity of events on G-20 Presidency and 1st Anti-Corruption Working Group Meeting to all newspapers, agents and distribute in the run up to the event. The work is attached in media by mail to the PMU, H Dept, Govt. of Haryana.

- 13. The District Administration Gurgaon was directed to identify and spread up essential facilities near the venue for any unforeseen emergency, and provide round the clock medical facility at the venue along with two ALS Ambulances.
 [Action by: DC Gurgaon]
- 14. The District Collector Gurgaon and CEO GADA were directed to provide the details regarding event and all issues (including the execution of orders) to the meeting. Further, necessary funding be released at times of execution and any other requirements.
 [Action by: Commissioner, DC Gurgaon; CEO GADA; Administrator HSV; Gurgaon]
- 15. It was decided that State Government will appoint, (LAW, DISCOM, HCS and SPS) to be invited by the Protocol Committee with such delegation and security provided at the 1st Anti-Corruption Working Group Meeting.

- 16. The Protocol Committee was directed to hold at least two special training workshops to the State Officers by Feb 19, 2023.
 [Action by: Protocol Committee, Resident Commissioner Haryana; Chief Protocol Officer, Gurgaon]
- 17. The Tourism Department was directed to organize a reception party at the New Delhi Hotel for the delegates arriving prior to the event, and formulate the reception plan in consultation with H Dept. Further arrangements be made for food, transport, along with arrangements with welcoming delegates at the airport and at the State House.

- 18. It was decided that a separate provision to be planned on March 4, 2023 will be the sole responsibility of the State Government. The Tourism Department will take all the local arrangements for the purpose, and the Principal Secretary, Tourism will act
